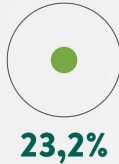

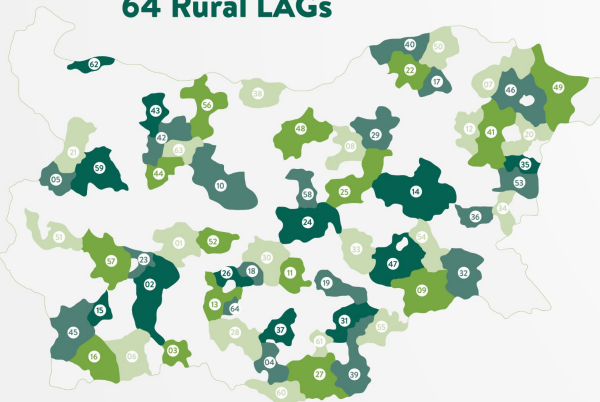
Local Action Groups (LAGs)

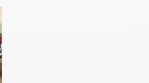
The Association Bulgarian national LEADER network represents around 2000 organisations from 55 LAGs covering about 50% of the rural areas of Bulgaria.
