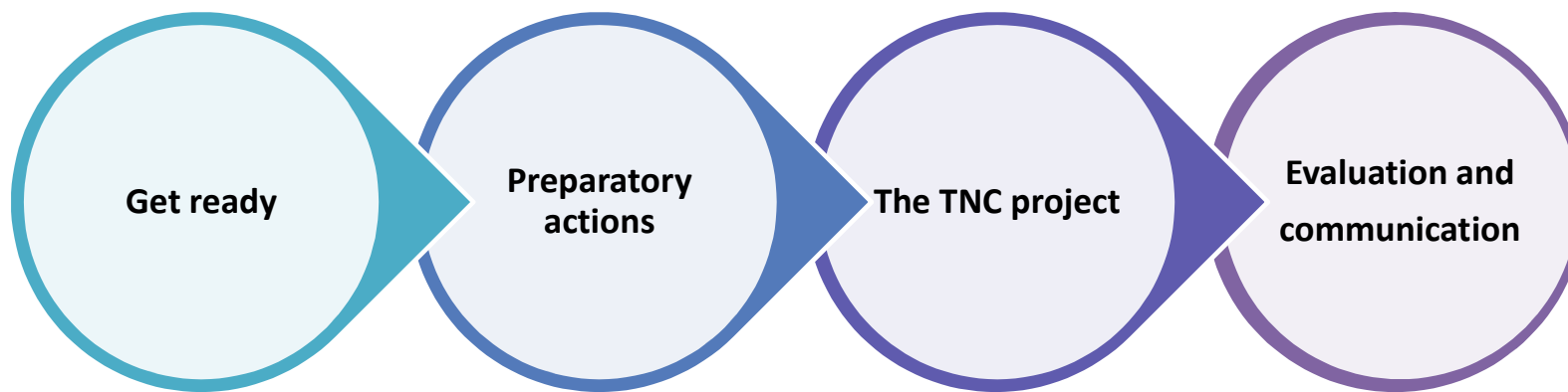

THE MAKINGS OF A 'GOOD' COOPERATION PROJECT - PROCESS



- Ensure support and involvement from the local level
- Network
- Initial enquiries re' potential partners

- Get to know your potential partners, meet them
- Prepare and agree detailed project proposal

- Set up and manage the partnership
- Activate and animate your partners – follow your 'roadmap'
- Monitor project implementation

- Prepare evaluation framework with project plan
Improve for next time
- Communicate project results
